Dr Gwen Fenton is the Chief Scientist at the Australian Antarctic Division. Gwen is responsible for delivering the Australian Antarctic Science Program which encompasses; Antarctic Research Programs, Science Planning and Coordination, Science Technical Support and the Australian Antarctic Data Centre. She was appointed to this position in December 2015. Gwen has worked at the Australian Antarctic Division since 2003 as the manager of science planning and coordination before being appointed as the Chief Scientist. Gwen represents Australia at the Scientific Committee on Antarctic Research (SCAR) delegates meetings and international Antarctic Treaty related meetings, is currently the Chair of the Australian Antarctic Program Animal Ethics Committee, a member of the National Climate Science Advisory Committee, a board member of the Antarctic Climate and Ecosystems Cooperative Research Centre (ACECRC) and the Marine National Facility (MNF), a member of the management committee for the Australian Research Council Special Research Initiative (ARCSRI) Gateway partnership, and a member of the University Research Committee (UTAS).
